

## Studying with a Disability is a Possibility!

The Student Disability Service (S.H.E. in French) is dedicated to accommodating and orienting students throughout their studies on campus.

The S.H.E. offers customised support as well as information and advice to students and future students with special needs enrolled at the University of Poitiers (on the Poitiers, Futuroscope, Châtelleraut, Niort, Angoulême, and Segonzac campuses).

Student Disability Services is a support which the University of Poitiers provides to all students with a disability: permanent or temporary (for example, a broken wrist).

It promotes and creates plans for students allowing them to study in the most optimal conditions possible, focusing on academic success and making the university a more inclusive place (for example, Campus Explorer Game, Aspie-Friendly Project, awareness Events).

Why should you register your disability with Student Disability Services? The S.H.E. allows you to:

- Request accommodations for your studies and examinations (addition of time for exams, adjustments to exam topics, the use of a certain support material)
- Set up a support plan according to your personal needs and not those of the disability
- Have individualised and personalised support (confidential appointments) all throughout the year
- Have more independence
- Renew your accommodation agreements each year (or during the academic year if necessary)

What is the procedure to apply for an accommodation?

1. Interview with Student Disability Services (S.H.E.) with the head of S.H.E.
2. Interview with Student Health Services (S.S.U.) and a doctor from the S.S.U.
3. Creation and finalisation of the accommodation agreement through collective consultation
4. Applying the accommodation notice

Accommodations can be modified throughout the year and must be renewed at the start of each academic year.
